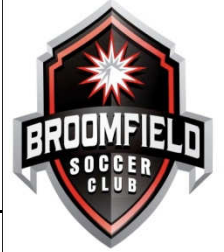

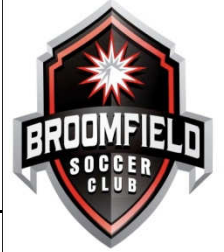

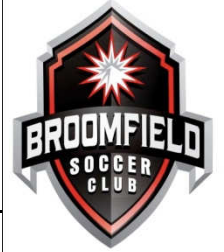

Team Formation Overview

- Teams are neighborhood/school based according to BSC Team Formation Policy per CYS rules
- Policy was modified and implemented in Fall 2008, older teams were grandfathered in unless otherwise requested
- Goal is to foster a sense of community
- Consistent throughout the club – Small Fry, Lower League, Middle League, Upper League
- Neutral Methodology that avoids the stacked team problem
- Teams stay together unless parent requests to opt out
- Coaches cannot request players. Parents choose the division and tier to register their child. We do our best to honor team, buddy, and practice requests.

Game Day Reminders

- **Micro soccer – (small field & small goal)**
- **3 versus 3**
- **Coaches are the referees**
- **No goalies**
- **No throw in. Kick in always**
- **Teams play only on Saturday. No weekday practices.**
- **Teams are 8-10 kids**
- **BSC League – all games played against other BSC teams**
- **First ½ hour practice with whole team followed by short fruit snack**
- **Second ½ hour scrimmage, teams split into 2 squads and scrimmage each other (2- 12 minute halves)**
- **Snacks at the end of game**
- **Parent/Fans tunnel all players run through at the end of the game**

- **When and what are appropriate for snack?**
- **How do we honor the more mature player?**
- **Are uniforms required?**
- **I can't make a game, what should I do?**

- **How often and when should I make substitutions?**

First week as a coach. Expectations.

1. Find your Coaching Partner tonight
2. Rosters will be sent electronically tonight.
3. Make Contact with Your Players (1-2 days)
 - Contact Information
 - Uniform Requirements
 - Equipment to Bring to Each Game
4. Pre-season Team Meeting (before first game)
 - All players arrive 15 min early
 - Parents Sideline and Post-Game Behavior
 - Team manager to help coordinate snacks and pictures
 - Season Schedule
 - Weekly Reminder Emails
 - Review updated inclement weather procedure
5. Post-season Gatherings
 - Hold a special end of year awards ceremony

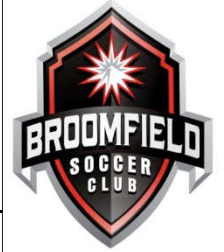
Roles of Educators

Blast Trainers, Challenger Trainers, Coaches

- **Inspire Coaches, Parents and Players to love this game and BSC!!!**
- **Be early and have a plan**
- **Utilize the training options provided by BSC**
- **Become a student of the game**
- **Talk to others coaches and learn from each other**
- **Promote off-season fitness while recognizing that Rec soccer allows for outside activities**
- **Give the players and parents an excellent experience**

BSC Player Training

- **Developmental Focus – develop a love of the game and ball**
- **Player should be excited about soccer outside of soccer**
- **Challenger will be out for at least 2 Sessions**
- **Players site on website will have additional resources for players to train on their own and get inspired**
- **Challenger Training U4 – U8, U11 and up**
- **Blast Academy Training – U9, U10 split between Wed and Fridays Good time to pick up coaching ideas**

Keys to Success (Practices)

- **Coaches wear your shirts and represent BSC**
- **Be early - set that expectation with parents**
 - **Goal Setup (1st game)**
 - **Goal Take down (last game)**
- **[Index Card \(have a plan\)](#)**
- **Practice progression**
- **Developmental Focus**
- **Good ball to player ratio**
- **No absolutes**
- **Encourage creativity**
- **No lines, laps or lectures**
- **Be clear, precise and simple**

Keys to Success (Games)

- **Coaches pre-game meeting**
- **Home = Red and Away=White**
- **Follow the rules set by the Club**
- **Positive cheering from everyone**
- **Honor referees and opponents as you honor your own team**
- **50% playing time for all players**
- **First ½ hour is a practice session and second ½ hour is a game**
 - **Snack between session and game**
 - **Away teams switch sides after half time of game**
- **Shake hands**
- **Fan Tunnel**
- **Seek out feedback after each session – be proactive not reactive**

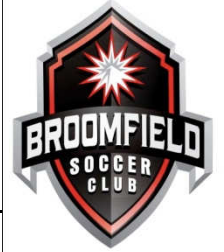
Code of Conduct

Policy:

- **Members of the Broomfield Junior Soccer Club (BJSC) – recreation and competitive – will not direct any negative comments, sounds, or gestures to the referees, or to their own or opposing coaches, players, or spectators.**
 - **The coach is the one source of communication on the field. All comments shall be made to the BJSC coach involved in the game at an appropriate time.**
 - **It is expected and encouraged that coaches, players and spectators will cheer and encourage outstanding play and sportsmanship at all times for both teams participating.**
- **This policy can be summarized as: *“Just Cheer!”***

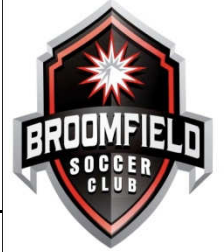

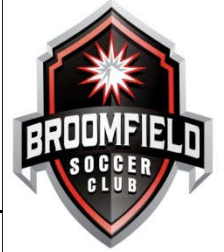
